



2019 Laymon N. Miller Award Call for Nominations

Nominations Due: March 1, 2019

The Laymon N. Miller Award for Excellence in Acoustical Consulting is an annual award developed jointly by the National Council of Acoustical Consultants (NCAC) and the Institute of Noise Control Engineering of the United States of America (INCE/USA). This award is to be provided to an individual who has practiced acoustical consulting in an exemplary manner over a sustained period of time to improve acoustical environments in and around buildings, transportation systems, work places, recreational and other occupied spaces such that the quality of life for citizens and communities is significantly enhanced.

The award will be independently bestowed by NCAC in odd numbered years and independently by INCE/USA in even numbered years to an individual who has not previously received the award from either INCE/USA or the NCAC, and who is deemed worthy of recognition for his/her outstanding acoustical consulting services and professional contributions that reflect the stated purpose of the award and provide inspiration to professional colleagues.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

Examples of achievements and qualifications to be considered include, but are not limited to the following:

- Length of time and quality of service as an acoustical consultant.
- Consulting and other contributions directed at improving quality-of-life through better acoustical environments.
- Development of new criteria, standards and improvements of existing criteria and problem solving approaches.
- Publication of technical articles, handbook chapters, application manuals, etc.
- Teaching courses in acoustics and noise control engineering.
- Service as a mentor to colleagues, especially those newly entering the field of acoustical consulting.

Nominations should include a brief description of the nominee's qualifications and reference letters supporting the nomination from at least two NCAC member firms. ***Please complete the attached application and submit all materials to the NCAC office (info@ncac.com or fax to 317-280-8527) no later than March 1, 2019.*** The recipient will be notified no later than July 15, 2019. The award will be presented during the NCAC annual meeting, September 13-15, 2019 in Atlanta, GA.
